Evaluation Criteria (As per Clause 3.5 of RFP)

The proposals have been evaluated based on the technical bid and financial bid submitted by the bidder. Technical and financial evaluation have been rated out of **70% and 30%** respectively **based on Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) Method**. Firstly, the Technical bids were opened and evaluated. Technical bids from successful bidders securing **70% or more in Technical Bid Evaluation** have been considered for the **Financial bid evaluation**.
