The ITCN Training and Capacity Building Programme on behalf of NIUA had posted a Request For Proposal (RFP) for **Consultant Agency/Firm/Institution for undertaking the assignment of "Training of Trainers"** on the 12th May, 2021 inviting applications from 35 empanelled institutions under MoHUA's Integrated Capacity Building Programme.

Evaluation Criteria (As per Clause 3.4 of RFP)

The proposals have been evaluated based on the technical bid and financial bid submitted by the bidder. Technical and financial evaluations have been rated out of 70% and 30% respectively based on Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) Method. Firstly, the Technical bids were opened and evaluated. Technical bids from successful bidders securing 75% or more in Technical bid Evaluation have been considered for the Financial bid evaluation.
